You will be informed of the acceptance of your application upon review by our committee (approx. 2 weeks). Our goal is to showcase a diversity of vendors. The Icelandic Festival of Manitoba retains the right to refuse and return payment on applications not accepted by the committee.

Upon acceptance payment is required.

Maps indicating vendor placements will be sent out prior to the festival. Please bring your receipt/confirmation and map showing your space location with you on festival weekend.

Refunds will be made if the vendors are not allowed due to COVID-19 Provincial Health regulations. If you are unable to attend after your application and payment has been received because of special circumstances (ex. medical or compassionate), you may submit a written request for review to the Icelandic Festival with an explanation.

If the reason is deemed valid, the Festival Executive will consider holding over your fee to the following year. In exceptional cases, where carry-forward is not possible, the Committee will consider refunding a portion of the fee.

2022 Icelandic Festival of Manitoba Vendor Application Rules and Regulations

All vendors agree to follow these regulations which govern their participation in the Icelandic Festival of Manitoba (IFM)

1. Vehicles must be unloaded from First Ave. Set-up times for each day of the Festival is 8:00 AM to 10:00 AM (all vehicles must be out of the vendor area by 9:30 AM).
2. Space is allocated by the vendor committee. Please do not move without permission.
3. IFM provides no booth or sun cover. Vendor booths are not to be taken down before 6:00 PM on Saturday and Sunday and before 4:00 PM on Monday. Vendors may stay later if they wish.
4. All displays, tables, chairs, canopy, etc. must fit within the 12 x 12 vendor space provided. If you require more space, you are encouraged to book two spaces.
5. All booths must be cleared away each night. Vehicles are not allowed in the vendor areas until after take-down each day.
6. Please be advised that security is not provided.
7. Overnight camping is not allowed on town property or in the park.
8. IFM is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged property.
9. IFM is primarily an outdoor festival and is therefore subject to unpredictable weather conditions. The Festival cannot guarantee crowd size or profit.
10. There shall be no subletting of space.
11. No drug paraphernalia or weapons shall be sold or displayed.
12. Any vendors who have not paid in full by **July 15th, 2022** will be considered as not attending and have their space re-allocated.
13. Please keep your area clean.
